



Non Principal Private Residence (NPPR) Charge – Deadline 30th June 2011

The NPPR charge is an annual charge of €200 per property which was introduced by the Local Government (Charges) Act 2009 in respect of non principal private residential properties. Essentially, a non principal private residence is any dwelling which is not used by its owner as his or her sole or main residence.

The 2011 charge is based upon the ownership and status of the property on the 31st March 2011. Payment of the charge for 2011 must be made by the 30th June 2011 in order to avoid application of a late payment fee. Penalties of €20 per month or part of a month will continue to roll up as long as the charge remains unpaid.
